SERMON TITLE: Noah

SCRIPTURE: Genesis 6:7-9:17

DATE PREACHED: September 8, 2019

WEEKLY CHECK-IN:

This is a time to check in with your group.

Last week we discussed Cain and Abel and the condition of our heart. We challenged each other to demonstrate an act of love to someone in our family. How did you demonstrate that this past week?

Also, as a part of catching up on each other's week, this would be a good time to gather everyone's prayer requests and praises. This allows for everyone to share about their life and you can use this to guide your prayer at the end of the discussion.

DISCUSSION STARTER:

What's the biggest weather storm you have been caught in? Where were you, what type of storm was it, and how did you handle the storm?

DISCUSSION:

Read the scripture text as a group. If you were unable to worship with us on Sunday, you can watch this week's sermon at my.worthingtoncc.org/listen.

1. What in this week's scripture was most interesting?
2. Read the description of Noah in verse 9. If we were writing a story about you, how would you want to be described in just a few sentences?
3. If you were Noah, what would have been the most difficult thing for you in this passage?
4. Noah stood out in a spiritually dark world. Have you ever been in an environment where you felt spiritually isolated? How did you handle the situation?
5. Noah did all that the Lord had commanded. How is faith and obedience connected? If we have faith, what makes obedience so difficult?
6. Genesis 8:1 says, "God remembered Noah." How do you think these words would have affected Noah? In what area of your life do you need to be reminded of this same promise?
7. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
8. What does it teach us about people?

MY NEXT STEP:

Noah walked faithfully **with** God. What spiritual step can you take this week to be **with** Jesus?

PRAYER:
