SCRIPTURE: Genesis 12:1-9

DATE PREACHED: September 15, 2019

WEEKLY CHECK-IN:

This is a time to check in with your group.

Last week we talked about Noah walking faithfully with God. In what ways were you with Jesus this past week?

Also, as a part of catching up on each other's week, this would be a good time to gather everyone's prayer requests and praises. This allows for everyone to share about their life and you can use this to guide your prayer at the end of the discussion.

DISCUSSION STARTER:

If you could live anywhere in the world, where would you live?

DISCUSSION:

Read the scripture text as a group. If you were unable to worship with us on Sunday, you can watch this week's sermon at my.worthingtoncc.org/listen.

1. What in this week's scripture was most interesting?
2. God gave a great blessing to Abram (who will eventually be called Abraham). What part of the blessing sticks out to you most?
3. God told Abram to leave the comfortability that he was used to and verse 4 says, "so Abram went." In what ways do you feel God calling you to leave your comfort zone? What do you think would happen if you moved in this direction?
4. In verse 7 God gives Abram a glimpse into the future. If you could have a glimpse into the future, what would you like to have answered?
5. Read Galatians 3:6-9. Verse 7 says "those who have faith are children of Abraham." What does it mean to be "children of Abraham?" What does that encompass?
6. What can we learn about God from this week's scripture?
7. What does it teach us about people?

MY NEXT STEP:

In this passage, Abram keeps moving through destinations and throughout his journey he gives thanks to God. In your current phase of life (current destination), what areas of your life do you need to stop and give God thanks?

PRAYER:
